**Music majors are defined as those persons enrolled in applied music, major ensemble, and theory, aural skills, and class piano (unless the requirements are completed). For music majors, the scholarship is renewable each semester so long as the following minimums are maintained: (1) the overall scholastic average required by the University of all full-time students; (2) a 2.6 grade point average in music courses; (3) a grade of "C" or higher in all Music Theory courses (MTC designations) and in Class Piano (MUP 101, 201, 202); (4) the requirements as outlined in paragraph 2 above; and (5) the continued recommendation of the scholarship committee in the area.*
