A student shall continue probation as long as his/her current semester GPA is 2.0 or higher and until his/her SFA cumulative GPA rises to or exceeds 2.0. A student currently on academic probation is placed on academic suspension at the end of any fall or spring semester in which his/her current semester GPA is less than 2.0.

All Students on Academic Probation Status are required to meet with their Director or Associate Director to create a Personalized Success Plan (PSP) to help you return to good academic standing as soon as possible. Students on Academic Probation Status for the first time are required to meet with their Academic Success Advisor once a month during the semester of probation. Your Academic Success Advisor may also require additional meetings based on semester performance at his/her discretion.
